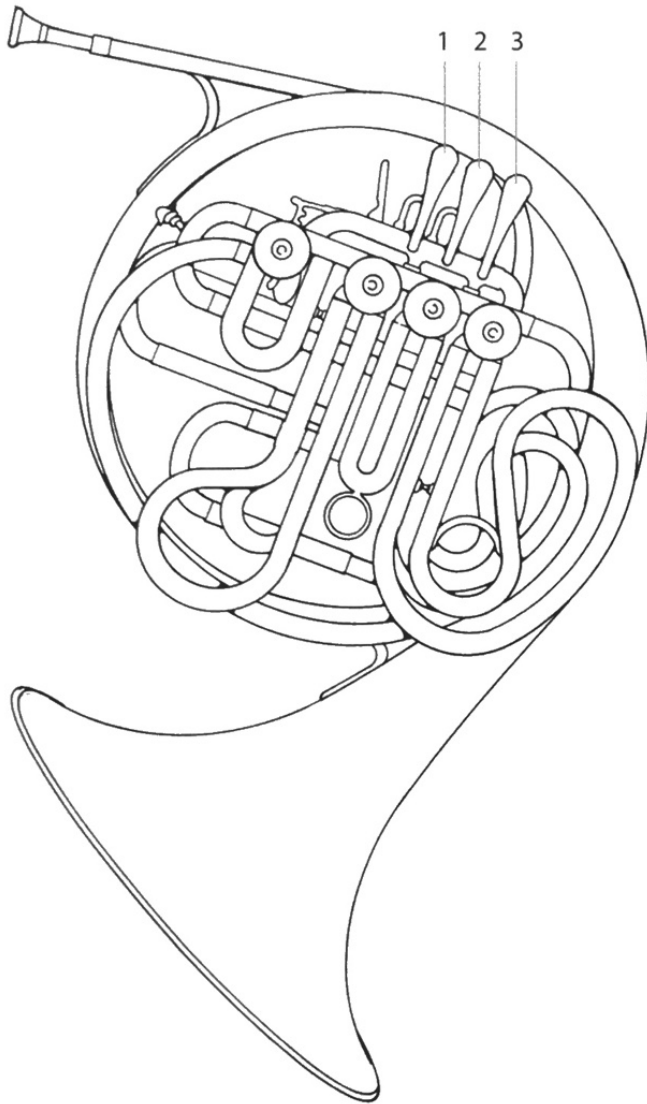


F Horn Fingering Chart



The numbers indicate which levers should be pressed down. Use the top fingering if you play an F horn. Use the fingering in parentheses if you play a B \flat horn.

Use either fingering if you play a double horn. Depress the thumb lever to switch from the F side to the B \flat side of your double horn.

0 = no levers pressed down
